ALC Appoints New Director of International Contracts

DVD And CBT Hit ALC

ALC is on schedule to complete the upgrade of its multimedia division by incorporating DVD and CBT technology to its services. With the delivery of its upgraded AVID system, ALC is now capable of compressing video and audio to the level of Digital Video Discs (DVD) and



also to use the same compression ratio in the publication of Computer Based Training (CBT) material for many of its clients. This service is enhanced by the multi-lingual capabilities of the company, as well as the in-house technical personnel and equipment that currently furnish broadcast-quality video production.

Early in 2001, ALC also anticipates launching its video streaming service, which the company anticipates will become a standard in computer-based training in multiple languages through the Internet.

Pending GSA Schedule

ALC is approaching the final stages of its GSA Schedule for Video and Audio Production. Perhaps the most significant twist in the service will be that ALC can script, narrate, and produce broadcast-quality videos and film in more than 100 foreign languages and English.

According to ALC's President and CEO "...the company should be on board within the next thirty to sixty days. This represents a big step in the right direction, as it will help our Government clients minimize time-consumption and take full advantage of our services. ALC will eventually become a true one-stop-shop."

The new item in the GSA Schedule will broaden ALC's capabilities and incorporate an innovative twist to the company's overall GSA contract: video and audio production in multiple languages.
